

WEDDINGS AT MMoCA

The Madison Museum of Contemporary Art, located in the heart of downtown, is one of the most sophisticated spaces in Madison and an architectural gem of the Midwest. Featuring an outdoor Sculpture Garden overlooking the Capitol building and the State Street pedestrian mall, MMoCA is the ideal spot for wedding ceremonies, receptions, engagement parties, rehearsal dinners, post-wedding brunches, and other celebrations.



WEDDINGS PACKAGE

MMoCA's Weddings Package includes use of the Rooftop Sculpture Garden, Lobby, and Lecture Hall as weather and event needs dictate, as well as all museum fees, including security, staffing, custodial costs, and vendor load-in/load-out assistance. The Weddings Package also includes use of the space for a ceremony rehearsal prior to the event and the museum's classroom as a staging/dressing area on the day of the event (available most dates).

MMoCA's spaces can accommodate up to 230 guests for a wedding ceremony, between 80-100 guests for a formal, sit-down dinner, and up to 175 guests for a cocktail-style reception, featuring a combination of plattered options, carving stations, and passed appetizers.

In addition to the weddings package rate listed below, couples hosting a wedding at MMoCA must become MMoCA members at the \$250 Langer Society level. This membership may be given as a gift if the couple is not in the Madison area.

MMoCA is honoring 2022 prices for events hosted at the museum in 2023 until a new in-house catering team has been selected.

CATERING

MMoCA is engaged in some promising discussions with a local restaurateur and anticipates that a new restaurant and caterer will open in 2023.

During this transition period, couples hosting an event at MMoCA are welcome to bring in licensed caterers to further customize their wedding. MMoCA is also working on a list of pre-approved caterers who are familiar with the space to help guide couples with their selection.

MMoCA encourages couples to find a “full-service” catering company that has experience with all aspects of event coordination and/or work with a wedding planner to oversee logistics during the event. The museum event team will help on-board vendors, schedule deliveries and assist with load-in and load-out, but the caterers will handle most planning and day-of setup components for the event, such as setting up tables, chairs, and other rented items, decorations, and AV equipment.

The third floor dining room is available to rent in conjunction with a Sculpture Garden rental during this transition period. Kitchen space is available as a staging area for caterers at no additional cost.



HOURS

Ceremony-only events are a 2-hour rental and must conclude no later than 2:30 pm on Saturdays during peak months. More flexibility is available on Fridays and Sundays and in the off-season.

Ceremony and Reception or Reception-only events can start at 5 pm. To start at 4 pm, there is an additional \$100 fee.

The Sculpture Garden is closed to the public two hours before event start time to allow time for set-up. Earlier set-up is possible with prior approval. The rain call is made three hours before the event start time, or when the first vendor arrives. All events must end by 11 pm.
